

New Customs Rules for transshipment (T/S) Cargo via Shanghai to Destination within China Mainland

According to Decree of the General Administration of Customs People's Republic of China No. 193, new clearance procedure will be adopted and Shanghai Customs implemented new manifest requirements for import cargo T/S via Shanghai since Jan 7th 2019.

For shipment T/S via Shanghai to destination within China mainland, the correct contact information of the consignee must be maintained in system, so that POD agent can make contact with the customer in time to collect necessary information.

Pls take care to provide the information in time in order to avoid detention and inspection of the shipment in Shanghai.

Shanghai Customs specifies following requirements for shipment transshipment cargo via Shanghai to destination within China mainland:

1. In case detailed cargo description and 10-digit HS CODE are manifested, customs system will complete verification for clearance automatically.
2. If there's no cargo description or 10-digit HS code of certain B/L in the manifest, on-site manual clearance procedure is required (and the cargo is likely to be inspected).

Based on above requirements we will coordinate relevant POD agents to contact the consignee and collect necessary information (10-digit HS code and detailed cargo description in Chinese) in time.
