

Great Britain and Japan sign historic free trade agreement

The UK signed a free trade agreement with Japan on Friday, September 11, 2020, which is the first major trade deal as an independent trading nation and will increase trade with Japan by an estimated £15.2 billion.

The agreement is tailored to the UK economy and will provide additional benefits beyond the EU-Japan trade deal, giving UK companies exporting to Japan a competitive advantage in a number of areas. It will help to create jobs and drive economic growth across the UK.
