

Beirut: Current Port and Service situation

Please be informed that due to the very heavy explosion in Beirut / Lebanon caused by a large storage depot of fertilizer ammonium nitrate chemicals the service to Beirut Port is disrupted for the time being.

Due to this dramatic incident all activities at the Beirut Container Terminal are currently suspended. In order to ensure business continuity, the carriers have made emergency arrangements for any cargo concerned in or out of Beirut Port until normal operations will resume. These arrangements include alternative ports such as Haifa, as a main replacement Port, Tripoli, Gioia Tauro, Tekirdag, Mersin and Piraeus.

As a precautionary measure carriers are temporarily not accepting any cargo directly to and from Beirut.

We regret to inform you that we currently cannot offer LCL service directly to Beirut. We are working intensively to find new solutions for your bookings.

We are monitoring the situation closely and will keep you informed of any further development on site.
